Applications for the Post-Doctoral Fellowship must include all relevant documentation listed below (items #1-#6). These documents should be submitted together as one application package. Applications must be received by no later than **Wednesday, 28 February 2018, 12:00 noon (EST)**. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Applications will be judged according to the following criteria:

- Overall academic excellence
- Completion of doctoral dissertation in a relevant discipline (on or after July 2015)
- Alignment of applicant research interests with the UCRSEA research agenda, including proposed research in one or more of the project's cities of focus: Koh Kong and Battambang, Cambodia; Dawei and Bago, Myanmar; Khon Kaen and Mukdahan, Thailand; and Lao Cai and Ninh Binh, Vietnam

DOCUMENTS TO INCLUDE:

1. **Project Abstract:** A short description of research proposed for the Fellowship year, not to exceed 250 words in length.
2. **Detailed Program of Research:** A program of research not exceeding 1,250 words in 12-point font and 1.5 spacing. Each page should be numbered consecutively and include the applicant's name and "UCRSEA Postdoctoral Fellowship" at the top right-hand corner. The proposal should be written for general academic readers and not for specialists in your field. The detailed program of research should describe:
 - a. the issue(s) to be studied;
 - b. the questions and goals of the proposed research;
 - c. the distinction between the current project and the PhD dissertation;
 - d. the way in which the project fits into the existing literature;
 - e. the potential contribution of the project to UCRSEA's research focus;
 - f. the methodology/ies to be employed; and
 - g. a proposed strategy for the dissemination of research.
3. **Bibliography:** The bibliography should not exceed two pages in 12-point font and 1.5 spacing. Applicants need only to include those works most relevant to their research project.

4. **Referees:** Names of three academic referees who may be contacted to provide a reference if the applicant is shortlisted.
5. **Current *Curriculum Vitae***
6. **Original Graduate Transcript**
